Your task is to listen to these stories and then create detailed 'summaries and opinion pieces' for each story in your Literacy Group on Edmodo.

First, you need to summarise the story (what is it about?). Then, you need to state what YOUR opinion is on the topic and also answer the questions listed below.

Year 7:

1. What is your opinion about this story?
2. You are going to be in high school in the next year or two. What do you personally think is the right age to move into high school? Why?
3. Some students find it hard moving from primary school to high school. What do you think can be done to make the process of moving easier on kids?
4. What are the main things you looking forward to in high school?

Stolen Generations:

1. What is your opinion about this story?
2. Do you think what the Australian Government did to aboriginal families in the 1900s was right or wrong? Why?
3. How would YOU feel if you were dragged away from your family and never saw them again? Describe this in detail.
4. The current Australian Government apologised for the 'stolen generations' incidents. What else do you think we can do to help aboriginal people?
