


Rabbit Proof Fence

Comprehension Questions



1. Briefly summarise the storyline of this movie in two paragraphs.
2. What is YOUR opinion of the movie and the Stolen Generations?
3. While the girls (and others) were at Moore River Camp, in what ways was their culture taken away from them? What long term effects might this have had on them?
4. How do you think the tracker felt about his job? And also about the girls' success in getting away from him? Explain why you believe he felt the way he did.
5. Have you ever judged someone because they do things differently to you? (Be honest!) Explain the situation in detail and reflect on your actions.
6. Describe the feelings explored throughout the movie from different character perspectives - a) the girls, b) the mothers, c) Mr Neville, d) the tracker.
7. Assess whether or not the actions of the Australian government at the time were just. Do you think it should have been the law? Does forcing someone to learn your culture, at the expense of their own native culture, do more harm than good? Explain your answer.
8. Even though the Stolen Generations happened a long time ago, do you think the Australian government of today has a responsibility to help Aboriginals? Why/why not?
