

Literacy Rotations - Week 7

Independent Learning Task

Learning intention:

To creatively express your understanding of the impact of bushfires/drought and volcanoes through building two connected, detailed trioramas.

Your task:

Using two pieces of A3 paper, cut them down into squares and fold in half diagonally. Cut one line into the centre of the paper, and fold it inwards to create a triorama. Repeat this process to make the second one.

Think about what sort of devastation a volcano or a bushfire (or drought) could cause - your task is to demonstrate this creatively by decorating the two trioramas to show scenes of these natural disasters.

You can use materials from the classroom (such as paper, cardboard) or collect them from outside (for example, little twigs/leaves, etc., can be broken up to represent trees, use dirt/rocks for mountains) and create realistic scenes showing the affects of these natural disasters.
